By taking the bread and the wine, you are acknowledging that you are a sinner, without hope except in God's sovereign mercy and that you are trusting in Christ alone for your salvation. If you would like to receive communion come to the front when your row is dismissed. Please take each element to your seat and hold onto them until all have been served so we can partake together. We will say, " <i>The body of Christ, broken for you</i> " as you receive the bread. As you receive the wine, we will say, " <i>The blood of Christ, poured out for you</i> ."
